

LEVINE ACT CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION DISCLOSURE FORM

All applicants are required to submit this completed Disclosure Form with their application for a discretionary land use permit, subdivision map or approval, or other discretionary land use entitlement (collectively, "Entitlement").

The Levine Act (Gov. Code, § 84308) provides that a party seeking an Entitlement is required to disclose campaign contributions made by them or their agent¹ to any County of Kern official or candidate within the preceding 12 months in an aggregated amount over \$500. Pursuant to FPPC Regulation 18438.8(b), such contributions must be disclosed upon filing of the application. In addition, any subsequent contribution made while the application is being processed must also be disclosed within 30 days and prior to the final decision. While your application is in process, you are required to submit a supplemental form disclosing any new campaign contributions over \$500, as aggregated, made to any County of Kern official or candidate within 30 days of making the contribution. This obligation only applies to contributions made to County of Kern officials or candidates with potential jurisdiction over your project.

Under the Levine Act, any County official receiving a contribution of more than \$500 from the applicant (or the applicant's agent) in the 12 months preceding the proceeding may be legally disqualified from participating in the decision. This may delay consideration of the application or require participation by alternate decision-makers.
